# Prime Minister's New 15-Point Programme for the Welfare of Minorities

### FREE COACHING AND ALLIED SCHEME FOR CANDIDATES STUDENTS BELONGING TO THE MINORITY COMMUNITIES

The Union Ministry of Minority Affairs invites proposals from institutions/centres for providing free coaching/training to students/candidates belonging to the minority communities notified under section 2(c) of the National Commission for Minorities Act. 1992 namely Muslims. Christians, Sikhs. Buddhists, Zoroastrians (Parsi's), Jains for the following:

- a) Qualifying examinations for admission in technical professional courses such as engineering, law, medical. management, information technology etc. and language/aptitude examinations for seeking admission to institute/universities.
- b) Competitive examinations for recruitment to Group 'A' 'B' . 'C and 'D' services and other equivalent posts under the Central and State governments including police security forces, public sector undertakings, Railways, banks, insurance companies as well as autonomous bodies.
- c) Coaching/training for jobs in the private sector such as in airlines, shipping, fisheries, information technology (IT), business process outsourcing (BPO) and other IT enabled services, hospitality, tours and travels, maritime, food processing, retail, sales and marketing, bio-technology and other job oriented courses as per the emerging trend of employment which does not ordinarily exceed nine months
- d) Remedial coaching for technical & professional courses at

undergraduate and post graduate level to improve academic knowledge and enable the student to catch up with the rest of the class and complete the course successfully. The remedial coaching will be imparted by the institute where the student is admitted to pursue technical/professional course.

#### 2. HOW TO APPLY

- The coaching/training institutes may submit their complete proposals in the prescribed application form (Part I & II) along with all necessary documents to the Department of the concerned State Government/Union Territory administration dealing with minority welfare for onward transmission to the Joint Secretary (PP), Ministry of Minority Affairs, 11th Floor, Paryavaran Bhavan, CGO Complex, Lodhi Road, New Delhi- 110003. The concerned State Department should have the project of the coaching institute inspected and then forward the proposal with specific recommendation in the prescribed format (Part III & IV of the application form) to the Ministry of Minority Affairs, Government of India in batches and not later than 31st October, 2009. The institutes in the government sector can send their proposals in the prescribed application form directly to the Ministry of Minority Affairs, Government of India before the specified date.
- 3. The details of the scheme, including eligibility criteria for coaching/training institutes and candidates/students, stipend payable to candidates/students, fee payable to the coaching/training institutes and application format can be seen and downloaded from the website of the Ministry of Minority Affairs http://minorityaffairs.gov.in.

## SCHOLARSHIP FOR MINORITIES STUDENTS

Students belonging to the Muslim, Christian, Sikh, Buddhist, Jains and Parsi communities, notified as minority communities under section 2 (c) of the National Commission for Minorities Act, 1992 are eligible to apply for one of the following scholarships of the Ministry of Minority Affairs, Government of India

## Scheme of pre-matric scholarship for minorities

- Scholarships will be awarded to eligible students of class to X in government I recognized private schools/institutes.
- Financial assistance includes admission / tuition fees and maintenance allowance.
- Students who have scored not less than 50% marks in the previous final examination, and whose parents' / guardian's annual income does not exceed Rs. 1 Lakh, are eligible for the scholarship. 50% marks requirement will not apply to class I students.

## Scheme of post-matric scholarship for minorities

- Scholarship will be awarded to eligible students of class XI upto Ph.D in government/ recognized private schools I colleges/ universities / institutes including technical and vocational courses of ITI's / ITCs (affiliated with NCVT) of class XI and XII level and the courses other than those covered under merit-cum-means scholarship scheme.
- Financial assistance includes admission/ tuition fees and maintenance allowance.
- Students who have scored not less than 50% merits in the previous final examination and whose parents'? guardian's annual income does not exceed Rs. 2 lakh, are eligible for the scholarship.

## Scheme of merit-cum- means scholarship for minorities

- 60,000 new scholarships will be awarded to eligible students studying In technical/professional courses at under graduate and post-graduate levels.
- Financial assistance includes reimbursement of course fees and maintenance allowance.
- Full course fee Is reimbursed for 70 listed Institutes in the scheme. Course fee upto a maximum of Rs.20,000/- is reimbursed for other institutes
- The annual income of the parents or guardian of the Student Should not exceed Rs.2.50 lakh from all sources

#### Students can apply for one of the above scheme only

In each scheme, 30 % of scholarships are earmarked for girls belonging to the minority communities

The demand will be prepared by the Head of the concerned school/Institution, for further submission to District Education Officer of the district, in the shape of Hard and Soft Copies. The concerned District Education Officer will consolidate the demand of all schools and forward in the shape of soft copies in a single lot to the Director, Welfare of Scheduled Castes & Backward Classes Department (Minority Wing), Punjab, in the following format latest by 10th Sept, 2014.

#### Eligibility conditions to apply:-

- a) Student who have secured not less than 50% marks in the previous final examination.
- b) Annual income from all sources of the students' parents or guardian should not exceed Rs. One Lac.
- student obtaining benefits under this scheme will not be allowed to avail of any other benefit under any other scheme for pursuing the same course.
- d) Scholarship will not be given to more than two students in a family.
- e) Parent/Guardian and the student should be domicile of Punjab State.
- f) Student should be regular in attendance.

#### Centrally Sponsored Scheme of 'Pre-Matric Scholarship'

Attention of Minority students with family income below Rs.1,00,000/-per annum is invited for scholarship to be awarded to the students who have secured not less than 50% marks in the previous final examination.

#### CONDITIONS FOR SCHOLARSHIP

- Scholarship will be available to the students of minority community studying in Classes I to X. The continuance of award will be subject to securing 50% marks in the previous examination. Maintenance allowance will be provided to hostellers and day scholars.
- 2. The award will be discontinued if a student fails to secure 50% marks in the annual examination except in case of unavoidable reasons to be certified by the Principal/competent authority of the school and recommended by the State Government/Union Territory Administration.
- 3. Scholarship will not be given to more than two students from a family.
- 4. Students should be regular in attendance for which the yardstick will be decided by the competent authority of the school.
- 5. Course fee/Tuition fee will be credited to the school's/institute's bank account. Efforts will be made for transferring it electronically through the banks.
- 6. Maintenance allowance will be credited to the student's bank account.
- 7. If a student is found to have obtained a scholarship by false statement, his/her scholarship will be cancelled.
- 8. The student obtaining benefits under this scheme shall not be allowed to avail of benefits under any other scheme for this purpose.
- 9. If a student violates school discipline or any other terms and conditions of the scholarship, scholarship will be suspended or cancelled.
- 10. Scholarship will be awarded to the students who have secured not less than 50% marks or equivalent grade in the previous final examination and the annual income of whose parents/guardian from all sources does not exceed Rs.1 lakh. Unlike scholarship for SC and ST, there are a fixed number of scholarships for minorities and hence preference for selection has been laid down. Students from BPL families, having the lowest income shall be given preference in the ascending order. The renewal applications would be fully exhausted before the new applications are considered.

#### **DURATION FOR SCHOLARSHIP:**

The scholarships will be provided for the entire course. Maintenance allowance will be given for 10 months only in an academic year.

Note: The scheme will be implemented through the State Government/ Union Territory Administration

#### **REQUIREMENTS FOR SCHOLARSHIP:**

- 1. The applicant has to submit a proof of permanent residence. (Ration Card/Voter I.D. card/Domicile Certificate)
- 2. Minority community declaration/affidavit on non-judicial stamp paper by the student that he/she belongs to any one of the minority communities notified by Central Government.
- 3. Verification of the student to be furnished by the Head of the school/institute.
- 4. Income declaration affidavit on non-judicial stamp paper for self-employed parents/guardian or income certificate from the employer for employed parents/guardian.
- 5. Copies of certificates of educational qualifications attested by a Gazetted Officer.
- 6. Self attested passport size photograph with signature.
- 7. Bank Account should be in the name of the student.
- 8. Receipt in acknowledgment of scholarship in the previous year duly countersigned by the Head of the school/institute.

#### SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION FORMS (Refer instructions below Part-II of application)

 Students and their parents/guardian are advised to apply in the prescribed format given above to their respective School Principals/Head Masters who would forward the consolidated statement & application form and other attested documents including original fee.

- \* The scholarship will be awarded for studies in India in a government or private school from class I to class X, including such residential Government institutes and eligible private institutes selected and notified in a transparent manner by the State Government and Union Territory Administration concerned.
- \* Scholarship will be awarded to the students who have secured not less than 50% marks in the previous final examination and annual income of their parents/guardian from all sources does not exceed Rs. 1 lakh.
- \* EARMARKING FOR GIRL STUDENTS 30% of scholarship will be earmarked for girl students. In case sufficient number of eligible girl students are not available, then the balance earmarked scholarships may be awarded to eligible boy students.

#### Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) Pre-matric scholarship scheme for minority communities

#### Q.1. What is the pre-matric scholarship scheme for minority communities?

A. The objective of the scheme is to encourage parents from minority communities to send their school going children to school, lighten their financial burden on school education and sustain their efforts to support their children to complete school education.

Pre-matric scholarship scheme for minority communities provides the scholarship to students from class I to X studying in Government/ recognised private schools/ institutes in India. (See website:-www.minorityaffairs.gov.in)

#### Q.2. Who is eligible to apply for the pre-matric scholarship?

A. Students belonging to Muslim/ Christian/ Sikh/ Buddhist/ Parsi/ Jain who has secured not less than 50% marks in previous final examination and the annual income of his/her parents/ guardians from all sources not exceeding Rs. 1 lakh, can apply for the pre-matric scholarship in the prescribed application to the Department dealing with minority welfare of his/her State/UT, on advt. published by the State Government/ Union Territory Administration concerned.

#### Q.3. What is the financial assistance given under pre matric scholarship?

A. Under pre-matric scholarship, financial assistance for admission & course/tuition fee and maintenance allowance is given, as under:

#### \* CONDITIONS FOR SCHOLARSHIP

- (i) Scholarship will be awarded to the students who have secured not less than 50% marks or equivalent grade in the previous final examination and the annual income of whose parents/guardian from all sources does not exceed Rs.2 lakh. Unlike scholarship for SC and ST, there are a fixed number of scholarships for minorities and hence preference for selection has been laid down. Students from BPL families, having the lowest income shall be given preference in the ascending order. The renewal applications would be fully exhausted before the new applications are considered.

This scholarship is not available for LLB, MBA, MCA, BE and MBBS. (See website:-www.minorityaffairs.gov.in)

#### Q.2. Who is eligible to apply for the post-matric scholarship?

**A.** Students belonging to Muslim/Christian/Sikh/Buddhist/Parsi/Jains, who have secured not less than 50% marks in previous final examination and the annual income of his/her parents/ guardians from all sources not exceeding Rs. 2 lakhs, can apply for the post-matric scholarship in the prescribed application to the Department dealing with minority welfare of his/her State/UT, on advertisement published by the State Government/ Union Territory Administration concerned.

#### Q.3. Who can claim hostel reimbursements charges?

**A.** Hostlers include students who are not staying in hostel of the school/institute concerned but are staying as paying guest in rented accommodation in towns/cities which are not the places where their parents resides

#### Q.4 What if I am resident of particular state but pursuing studies in other state?

**A.** Your application after the authentications/verifivataion by your present institute will be sent to welfare department of the state to which you belong.

#### 5. CONDITIONS FOR SCHOLARSHIP (FRESH):

- i) Financial assistance will be given to pursue degree and/or post graduate level technical and professional courses from a recognized institution. Maintenance allowance will be credited to the student's account.
- ii) Students who get admission to a college to pursue technical/professional courses, on the basis of a competitive examination will be eligible for the scholarship.

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS TO HELP/SIMPLIFY ONLINE SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS UNDER POST MATRIC AND MERIT CUM MEANS BASED SCHOLARSHIP SCHEMES

#### Q.1. Who are eligible to apply for Post Matric and Merit-cum Means based Scholarship Schemes?

**Ans.** Students belonging to notified minority communities viz. Muslim/Christian/Sikh/Buddhist/Jain/Parsi (Zoroastrian) studying in India only and fulfilling the Scheme guidelines are eligible to apply for these scholarships.

#### Q.2. What is the last date for submitting applications online?

Ans. For Merit cum Means based Scholarship: In case of Fresh Scholarships for this year, students can apply online upto midnight of 30th September and in case of renewal of scholarships students can apply online up to midnight of 15th November.

**For Post Matric Scholarship**: In case of fresh scholarships for this year, students can apply online upto midnight of 15th September and in case of renewal of scholarships students can apply online upto midnight of 10th October.

#### Q.3. How can I apply online for scholarship?

Ans. The Post Matric and Merit cum Means based Scholarship Schemes are online Schemes. In order to apply online please visit the website through URL ww.momascholarship.gov.in link to the site is also provided in the website of the Ministry of Minority Affairs, i.e. www.minorityaffairs.gov.in.

#### Q.4. How to submit the online application?

Ans. Student applying as a Fresh applicant, have to go with the option "Student registration", whereas Renewal student have to follow the options "student registration - I know Permanent ID/ Don't know Permanent ID" on the home page of the Scholarship scheme. Fill up the application as per the instructions given by the system then click on save button.

After saving, student will get a "Temporary ID". The system will instruct the applicant to submit the Temporary id to fill up the next page. Once completed online registration click on "finalize and submit" button.

#### Q.5. Can I apply as a Fresh if I am a Renewal candidate?

Ans. No, you cannot apply as a fresh if you are a Renewal candidate. Your application will be rejected in that case.

#### Q.6. Do I have to fill up the online application in one sitting?

Ans. No. You can fill up the online application in as many sittings as you wish, until you are satisfied that you have entered all desirable fields correctly. The software provides facility to save your application at every stage until you click on 'submit & finalize' button.

#### Q.7. Can I edit the information already saved and upto what time?

Ans. You can edit information filled by you until you **finalize and submit** the online application.

#### Q.8. How should I open my saved application for editing?

Ans. Go to the option "Student Registration Update Student Details" then enter your Temporary ID, Date of birth and Mother's name to edit the application.

#### Q.9. What is to be done after submitting the online application?

Ans. In case of Fresh applicant, you should take a print out of the application then sign and send it immediately with requisite documents to the State Department after authenticating the application from your institute.

Whereas in case of Renewal the applicant have to upload the scan copy of the documents as per the instructions given at the time of applying.

Please ensure that your hard copy reaches to the State Department. You will not be considered for scholarship if the State Department of the State to which you belong to does not receive the hard copy of your duly filled in online application. It is the responsibility of the STUDENT to submit the Hard copy to the State Department.

#### Q.10. Which fields in the application form are mandatory?

**Ans**. Fields provided with red asterisk(\*) mark are mandatory fields.

#### Q.11. Which fields I can edit?

Ans. You can edit all fields except a few like parental income, mobile no. email Id etc. It may be noted that once you click on "Finalize and submit" button your application will be forwarded to the next level and then you cannot edit further.

#### Q.12. What happens, if I detect mistakes after forwarding the applications to the next level?

**Ans.** You should separately inform the mistakes detected by you to the Institute/District/Region/State. The software provides facility at the level of the Institute & State to edit & correct limited information.

#### Q.13. Which fields Institute/State can edit?

Ans. Except some basic parameters like religion, name of institution, parental annual income & bank details, the Institute/State can edit other fields. However, corrections made by the Institute/State, if any, would be conveyed instantly to the student through SMS/email. What the

student had filled up and the correction made by the Institute/State both would show up.

#### Q.14. What is UID number/Aadhaar Number?

Ans. UID number otherwise known as 'Aadhaar' number is Unique Identification Number given by Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI). The Aadhaar Number should be mapped with the Bank Account in which Scholarship Amount is desired to be transferred. For this the concerned Bank may be contacted with a copy of the Aadhaar card.

#### Q.15. Do I need to get my Aadhaar Card to apply for Scholarship?

**Ans.** Aadhaar no. is optional for the Students in order to fill up the application form online. Students can also apply for Scholarship without entering the Aadhaar no.

#### Q.16. What should I do, if I do not find my institute name in the drop-down menu?

Ans. You should immediately approach the institute to contact with the nodal officer of the State where the institute is located. You can also approach the Nodal Officer of that State directly through e-mail under intimation to the Ministry of Minority Affairs. If your institute is an eligible institution, the State Government concerned would enter it into the database and then you can apply.

#### Q.17. How do I know the name and address of Nodal Officer/ State Department of my State?

Ans. The name and contact details of the Nodal Officer/State Department of all States/UTs are available in "Contact us" option. Also you can get the address of the concerned state Department under "List" option available on the home page Post Matric and Merit cum Means based Scholarship Schemes.

#### Q.18. What is a Temporary ID?

Ans. Temporary ID (TID) is only a reference number provided to the applicants as a token of their registration in the online database. Receipt of TIDs does not give itself a guarantee for award of scholarship.

#### Q.19. What should I do if I forget my temporary ID?

**Ans**. The process of re-collection of the temporary id is given as below:

Student Registration->Update Student Details-> Don't know your Id then enter the basic fields accordingly and click on the button "Get Temporary Id".

#### Q.20. Can I take print-out of my application at any stage?

Ans. In case of Fresh you can take the print out of your application number of times once you submit and finalize the application. But in case of Renewal, student have to scan and upload the required documents in OSMS. Uploading option will be appear in Renewal form only.

#### Q.21. Do I have to scan the certificates and upload in the system before forwarding the online application to the institute?

**Ans.** Yes, the provision for the scanning of the documents and uploading in the system is available in case of Renewal only. The option for uploading documents will appear in Renewal application form. The list of documents to be uploaded is as under:

- 1. Institution Verification Form. (Mandatory)
- 2. Declaration of Family Income. (Mandatory)
- 3. Declaration of the Student. (Mandatory)
- 4. Attested Certificate of Last Exam Passed as filled in the Form. (Mandatory)
- 5. Fee Receipt of 'Current Course Year'. (Mandatory)
- 6. Proof of Bank Account in the Name of the Student. (Mandatory)
- 7. Income Certificate as required by the respective State Department in the advertisement. (In case of Parent/ Guardian are employed Income Certificate from the employer)- (optional)
- 8. Aadhaar Card (optional)
- 9. Proof of Address (optional)

#### Q.22. Is there any permanent ID?

Ans. Yes. A permanent ID (PID) will be provided to the candidate once his/her application is recommended by the State Department for scholarship. It will be conveyed to candidates through SMS and e-mail. Students should memorize their PID as it will be required while applying for renewal.

#### Q.23. How to check the status of my application?

Ans. Student can check the status of Online Application by submitting his/her Temporary/Permanent id in "Feedback" option given in the home page of Post Matric and Merit cum Means based Scholarship Scheme. Student can also check his/her submitted online application form by entering the basic informations given under the option student registration update student details.

#### Q.24. How and when will I know whether my application is selected or rejected?

Ans. If the application is recommended by the State Department for Scholarship a Permanent id will be provided to the student. By submitting that Permanent Id in "Feedback" option student can check whether his/her application is selected or rejected.
