BRIEF LIFE SKETCH OF FOUNDING FATHERS



Sant Attar Singh Ji

(1866 – 1927)

- Born on March 28, 1866 in Sangrur, Punjab.
- At seventeen enlisted as a gunner in the Artillery, later getting himself transferred to the 54th Sikh Battalion.
- prophesy was so clear for girl child education that he first set up a school for girls in 1906.
- He helped found several educational institutions such as Khalsa High School at Lyallpur and Chakwal, Missionary College and Guru Nanak Khalsa College at Ludhiana, Malva Khalsa High School at Sangrur.



Sant Teja Singh Ji

M.A. LLB, A.M. (Harvard)
(1877 – 1965)

- Niranjn Singh Mehta, who came to be known as Sant Teja Singh Ji later, was born on 14 May 1877.
- In 1902, cleared Civil Services Exam, further he went to esteemed universities like Cambridge, Harvard, Columbia and California .
- Appointed as first Sikh Principal of Khalsa College, Amritsar, at the age of 28 further he served many educational institutes.
- To fulfil the vision of Sant Attar Singh Ji, in 1956, Sant Teja Singh Ji revealed Baru Sahib, valley of divine peace.

Baba Iqbal Singh Ji

Msc Agriculture
(1926 –2022)

- Born on May 1, 1926, in Gurdaspur, Punjab.
- After completing his B.Sc., he took admission to M.Sc. Genetics and Plant Breeding at Ludhiana.
- Retired as Director – Agriculture Department, Himachal Pradesh.
- Opened 1st school in 1986 with 6 students, he worked tirelessly, and one by one, he established 129 school and 2 Universities.
- For his philanthropic and selfless services for social welfare, Baba Iqbal Singh Ji was awarded with 'Padma Shri' by Government of India on 26th January 2022.



Padma Bhushan

Dr Khem Singh Ji

Ex-Vice Chancellor

(1930 – 2019)

- Born on 1 September 1930 at Kaleke , a small village in the Punjab.
- Dr Khem Singh Gill graduated in Agricultural Science (BSc) from Khalsa College Amritsar, in 1949 and secured his master's degree (MSc) from Punjab University in 1951.
- Dr Gill founded the Crop Improvement Society of India in 1974; He served as its president until 1979.
- He got many facilitations from renowned stages and The Government of India awarded him the civilian honor of the Padma Bhushan in 1992.

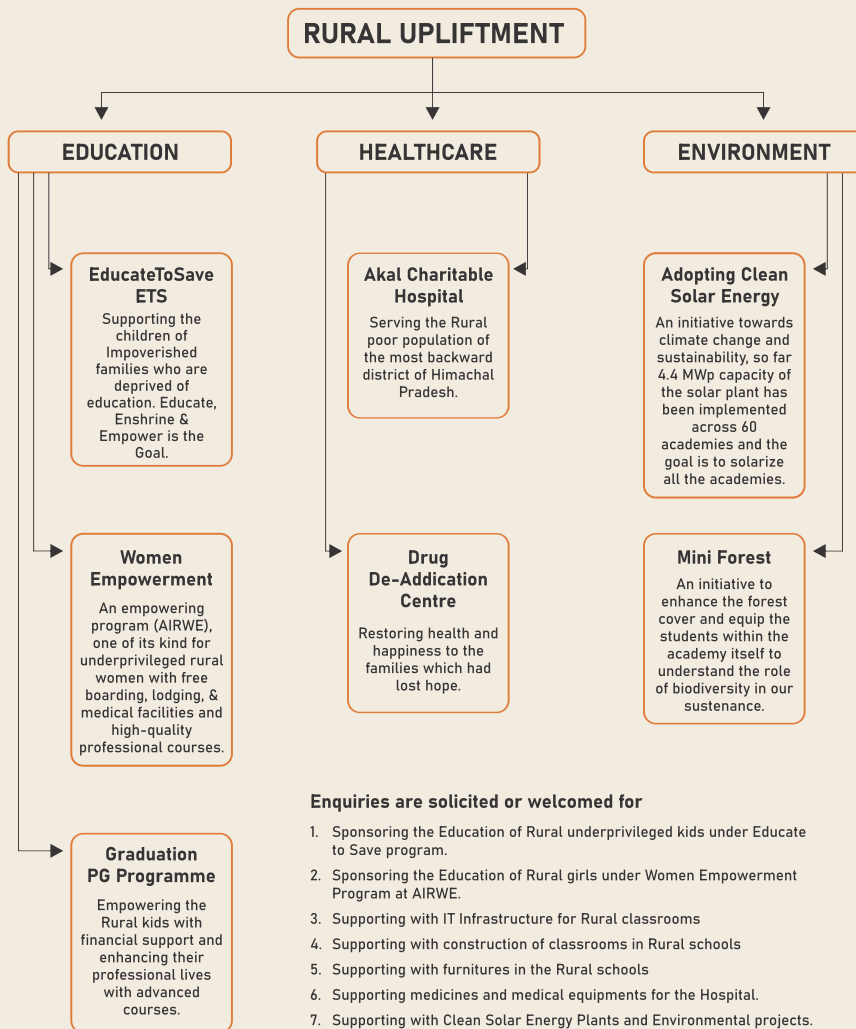

Akal Institute of Rural Women Empowerment (AIRWE) is a FREE residential program run by The Kalgidhar Society for underprivileged young women from remote areas of North India. They are provided education with a blend of modern scientific teaching and spiritual learning, which usually take 4-6 years, depending upon their aptitude at the time of admission. The centre is affiliated with the NIOS board and Eternal University (UGC approved). After completing education here, these girls quickly become eligible enough to secure service as educators or administrators in reputed schools. During their stay in this academy, these students avail free boarding, lodging, medical and other facilities. The programme also empowers the young girls emotionally, morally, and intellectually, instilling in them the virtues of selfless service, universal brotherhood, and a solid character to become future good human beings who will help improve society's general structure.

It is a fully functional hospital with all state-of-the art ultra-modern medical facilities. It provides medical care to the poor patients of the rural areas of backward Himalayan region. These patients and their attendants travel to hospital from remote far-flung areas to take treatment for various ailments and get cured.

Medical Camps: In addition to routine services, general medical camps and Ophthalmologic camps are organized 4-5 times a year. These camps see specialists with various medical specializations from USA, Canada, UK, Jalandhar, Chandigarh, Ludhiana, Delhi and Mumbai. In 2017 around 6,972 patients are benefitted and more than 392 operations were carried out free of cost in each of these camps.

DE-ADDICTION AND REHABILITATION



Akal Drug De-addiction and Rehabilitation Centre (Cheema Sahib and Akal Charitable Hospital Baru Sahib) is one of the humanitarian initiative of The Kalgidhar Society, Baru Sahib, which is a non-profit organization established in 1956 in service of upliftment of rural India (focus on northern India).

These Centres' has its outreach in rural areas where Psychiatry and Drug De-addiction care is not available. Addicts from weaker sections of society who cannot afford are being provided treatment at concessional rates or free of cost.

Ours is the largest centre located in a rural area and managed by an NGO. These Centres are well-known for providing its patients with comprehensive facilities relating to drug-addiction treatment. This holistic approach combines medical, psychological, spiritual, yoga and sporting activities.

The Society has established the first female Drug De-addiction facility at Akal Charitable Hospital, Baru Sahib, Himachal Pradesh.

After winning many laurels for their unique and value-driven education model, the Chain of Akal Academy Schools is now featured in LIMCA Book of Records for a massive rally against an important social issue "Drug Abuse".
